As part of the launch of the new DofE look and feel we have developed a FREE online e-induction programme. It will introduce you to the aim, ambition, structure and strategy of the DofE and the roles of the people involved.

to the DofE and gain clarity on their role and responsibilities.

After going through a welcome you can access a number of modules which include:

- **Introducing the DofE:** Introduces you to how we have developed into today's DofE, presenting our mission and the guiding principles which help us to achieve them. It also has a history timeline.
- **DofE programmes:** Explains the structure of DofE programmes, including programme sections and levels.
- **The DofE team:** Introduces the key roles in which you can help young people achieve a Duke of Edinburgh's Award.
- **The DofE experience:** A taste of what it is like to help young people achieve a Duke of Edinburgh's Award.
- **Support and Training:** An introduction to the range of resources, training and development opportunities we offer to support our Leaders and volunteers.

- **Delivery of the DofE programmes:** Explore where and how DofE programmes are delivered.

For those going onto further DofE training there is also a 'knowledge check' which is certificated. This e-induction programme will be a pre-requisite for all of those attending an 'Introduction to the DofE' course.
